CHILDHOOD TRAUMA TREATMENT PROGRAM

Reaching out to the community since 1979, the ADVOCATE CHILDHOOD TRAUMA TREATMENT PROGRAM provides a range of specialized services. Our mission statement is to provide and teach clinicians to deliver quality outpatient behavioral health care assessments, counseling, and psychotherapy for children, adolescents, and families that have experienced maltreatment, psychological trauma, sexual abuse, and sexual behavior problems.

CTTP has contracts with a variety of private foster care agencies and DCFS, and accepts most HMO/PPO health insurance plans. Individuals can be referred to CTTP under our DCFS-Medicaid Counseling/Sexual Abuse contract, DCFS-Medicaid General Counseling contract, DCFS-Medicaid Child Sexual Behavior Problem (formerly SACY) contract, and our DCFS-Medicaid Post Adoption contract. We do not accept Medicaid for our services at this time, but we do accept DCFS-Medicaid for families referred by a DCFS/foster care caseworker.

Among the services provided by Advocate Childhood Trauma Treatment Program:

Psychotherapy and Counseling Services: *Our staff provides these services to treat a variety of behavioral and psychological conditions, including sexual abuse, attachment disorders, Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), depression, anxiety, ADHD, maltreatment, trauma, child & adolescent sexual behavior problems, and other behavioral difficulties.*

Psychosexual (for children & teens with sexual behavior problems) & Trauma (Psychosocial) Assessments: *We provide psychological testing utilizing specialized interviews and a variety of psychological instruments to determine the treatment planning needs, appropriate interventions, and effective follow-up care for children and teens that have experienced trauma and sexual behavior problems.*

Foster Parent Support: *Foster parents are included in our treatment and are offered support and behavioral management training to stabilize foster care placements of children.*

Community Education Presentations: *Our staff offers educational presentations to the public and professional groups on various behavioral health topics, with continuing education credits available for LCPCs and teachers. We are also trained facilitators of the evidenced based Stewards of Children workshop for adults to learn how to prevent and react responsibly to child sexual abuse.
