- **Childhood Disorders:** Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Learning Disorders, Autism, Conduct Disorders, Separation Anxiety Disorder, Communication Disorders
- **Anxiety:** Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder, Posttraumatic Stress Disorder, Social Phobia
- **Mood Disorders:** Major Depression, Bipolar
- **Psychosis:** Schizophrenia, Delusional Disorder
- **Addictions:** Alcoholism, Drug Addiction, Pathological Gambling, Court orders for driving under the influence
- **Cognitive Disorders:** Mental Retardation, Alzheimer's Disease, Dementia
